## SPRING DAYS OF DRONE ACTION - 2014

### Beale Air Force Base, Marysville California

#### Goals:

1. **Activity:** We intend to recruit enough activists working in teams at each gate to make a significant appearance at each entry to the base during afternoon and morning commute hours.
2. **Action:** Centered on participation by veterans, who might interact with military personnel and have more influence on them while at the base,
2. **Educate:** Inform base personnel what drone warfare is doing to foreign countries and the world opinion of the United States and its military

#### Dates and Times:

**April 28, 2014** We have a long tradition of arriving early on Monday afternoon before the air force personnel begin the afternoon commute home to put up signs & banners, etc. We have demonstrations and pass out material between 3:00 and 5:00 PM. After 5:00 we take down the banners and flags and all come together at the Main gate on N. Beale Road, where there is a nice grove of trees, for a potluck dinner, encampment and conference to discuss our actions.

**April 29, 2014**, On Tuesday morning we get up early, pack our gear since we don't stay at the camp site, and get to each gate before 6:00 AM to set up signs, banners, etc. for the morning commute of air force personnel into the base. Traffic coming in usually starts to slow down by 8:00 AM. After picking up all of our materials and any trash we find along the road we meet at the Brick House coffee house in Marysville for breakfast and discuss what happened and make plans for future demonstrations.
